


Musket Cartridges

 soft brown paper used, also at
 times pages from books

paper rolled on wood
 former

powder for prime and
 charge about 100 grains
 of R.F. black powder




end twisted

75 cal.




To Load -
 This end is torn off
 and discarded.
 The part of the musket
 is primed and the rest
 of the charge is poured
 down the barrel, the paper
 and ball is then seated
 with the aid of the ramrod
 upon the powder charge.
